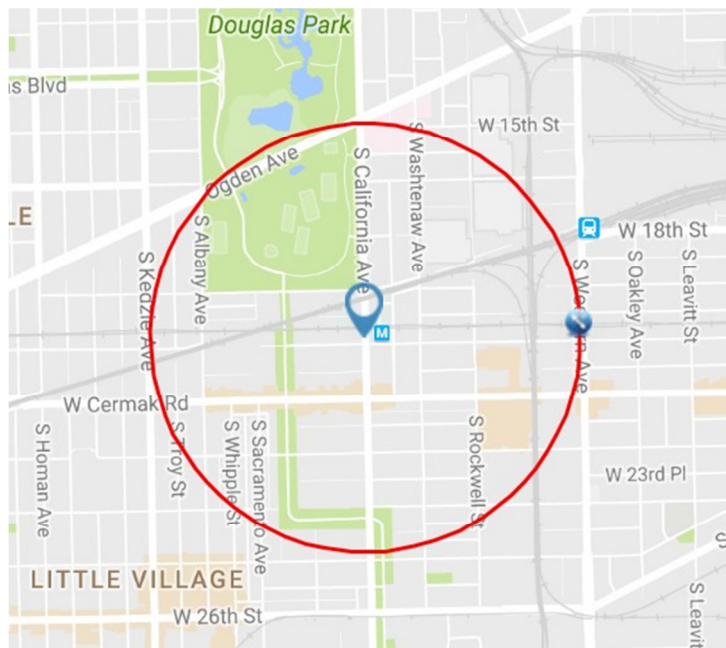


California Station - CTA Pink Line (1/2 mile area)
